
FATIMAH AZ ZAHRA/ RUQAYYAH CLASSES

UTHMAN CLASS



The children were also tasked to do research about a certain step of Hajj which was Muzdalifah and Rami, this task was given to the kids so that they could learn more about this part of Hajj and be able to explain it to their fellow students at the end of year assembly.
